



1.0 SCOPE

This specification describes the requirements for Class C uniforms (trouser, shirt) for the Military Department, California Cadet Corps.

2.0 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

2.1 CLASS C UNIFORM – COAT, UTILITY

The utility coat is identical in design to the October 2014 US Army OCP Combat Uniform. The coat shall comply with GL-PD-14-04A Standard dated 27 February 2015 configured as follows:

- 2.1.1 Style: Unisex.
- 2.1.2 Fabric: Ripstop 65/35 poly/cotton blend, solid Coyote brown color (pantone color 17-1036TPGm).
- 2.1.3 Buttons, hook and loop fastener tapes, threads, and slide fasteners, YKK Zippers, Two-Way (or equivalent) shall be Coyote Brown.
- 2.1.4 Identification and Care label (per 3.8.2 of GL-PD-14-04A) modified as follows:
 - 2.1.4.1 California Cadet Corps Uniform Unisex
 - 2.1.4.2 Delete: Contract Number
 - 2.1.4.3 Add in: Since 1911
- 2.1.5 Identification Friend or Foe (IFF) (per 3.7.10 of GL-PD-14-04A): remove IFF, webbing, hook but leave the 1-inch width loop fastener tape finishing by 3 ¼ inch in length.
- 2.1.6 Protective coating: None required.
- 2.1.7 Toxicity: EPA not required.
- 2.1.8 Integrated Patch Kit: Not Required.
- 2.1.9 Flag Label DAMSK WOVEN Size: ¾ inch x ¾ inch, fold in center,
 - 2.1.9.1 to read: "CACCC" on both sides of flag label.
 - 2.1.9.2 Location: Left chest pocket, bottom outside edge.
- 2.1.10 Sizes: As defined in Table IIIA (GL-PD 14-04A dated 27 February 2015).

2.2 CADET CORPS CLASS C TROUSERS – UNISEX

The utility trouser is identical in design to the October 2014 US Army OCP Combat Uniform. The trouser shall comply with GL-PD-14-05A Standard dated 27 February 2015 configured as follows:

- 2.2.1 Style: Unisex.
- 2.2.2 Fabric: Ripstop 65/35 poly/cotton blend, solid Coyote brown color (pantone color 17-1036TPGm to match coat above).

- 2.2.3 Buttons, hook and loop fastener tapes, and threads shall be Coyote brown.
- 2.2.4 Identification and Care label (per 3.8.2 of GL-PD-14-05A) modified as follows:
 - 2.2.4.1 California Cadet Corps Uniform Unisex
 - 2.2.4.2 Delete: Contract Number.
 - 2.2.4.3 Add in: Since 1911
- 2.2.5 Identification Friend or Foe not required.
- 2.2.6 Protective coating: None required.
- 2.2.7 Toxicity: EPA not required.
- 2.2.8 Integrated Patch Kit not required.
- 2.2.9 Flag Label DAMSK WOVEN Size: $\frac{3}{4}$ inch x $\frac{3}{4}$ inch, fold in center, to read: CACC on both sides of the flag label. Location: right leg, upper side cargo pocket, bottom edge of the pocket, centered on the side seam
- 2.2.10 Sizes: As defined in Table IVA (GL-PD 14-05A dated 27 February 2015).

3.0 QUALITY/WORKMANSHIP

Delivered uniforms shall be free from defects that will affect their appearance or serviceability. Examples of some of these defects are: holes, cuts, tears, spots, stains, objectionable odor, twisting/puckering, thread ends not removed, etc. As required in the bid, pre-production sample(s) must be submitted to the CA Cadet Corps for review and approval prior to commencing full production. These approved pre-production sample(s) will then serve as the standard(s) and used as reference(s) to compare material and workmanship quality of delivered products.

4.0 PRESSING AND PACKING

Uniforms shall be pressed neatly and individually packed in bags. Uniforms shall be bulk-packed and shipped in strong boxes so as not to be damaged in shipment. Sizes must be marked on the outside of the box at one end.
