**SECTION 1: BID IDENTIFICATION**

**SECTION 2: INTRODUCTION**

2.1 The intent of these specifications is to furnish information to responsible bidders for the purpose of obtaining bids for **Athletic and Physical Education Supplies and Equipment** as requested by **the BOCES and the above named participating School Districts**.

2.2 Complete sets of the Bidding Documents may be obtained or examined as stated in the Notice to Bidders. Complete sets of Bidding Documents must be used in preparing bids.

Capital Region BOCES does not assume any responsibility for errors or misinterpretations resulting from the use of incomplete sets of Bidding Documents.

- 2.3 Capital Region BOCES reserves the right to reject any or all bids in whole or in part, to waive any and all informalities, and to disregard all non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional bids.
- 2.4 This RFB does not commit the BOCES to pay any costs incurred in the preparation or submission of bids.
- 2.5 Any factual information contained in this RFB is for informational purposes only and is subject to independent verification by the bidder.

### **SECTION 3: SUBMISSION OF BIDS**

- 3.1 Bids and any other required documents must be submitted, sealed in an opaque envelope, plainly marked with the name and number of the bid and the name and address of the bidder, and accompanied by the required documents. Bids must be received no later than **2:00 P.M. LOCAL TIME ON THURSDAY, MARCH 12, 2026**, at the following address:

- 3.2 Unexpected Closures Due to Weather, Emergencies

In the event that the Capital Region BOCES Purchasing office is closed on the scheduled day and/or time of the bid submission deadline, the bid submission deadline shall be automatically rescheduled for the same time, on the next day that Capital Region BOCES Purchasing office is open.

### **SECTION 4: TERM OF BID**

- 4.1 The bid shall be in effect for the one-year period of **July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027**
- 4.2 At the end of the initial one-year bid term, upon mutual agreement of Capital Region BOCES and the Contractor, the bid may be renewed for **one (1)** additional years, in a consecutive one-year term.
- 4.3 Prices shall remain firm for the initial bid term. Only upon renewal, pricing may be adjusted consistent with the process described in Section 34: Price Redetermination.
- 4.4 Capital Region BOCES reserves the option at the end of any award term to execute a temporary 30-day extension for convenience, with mutual agreement of the awarded bidder(s).

**SECTION 5: SCHEDULE**

**SECTION 6: QUALIFICATION OF BIDDER**

6.1 The BOCES desires that all bidders possess certain qualifications to ensure high quality product(s). Therefore, bidders must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered for an award under this RFB:

- a. Bidder must have successfully provided product(s) of similar type and specifications to that to be provided to BOCES prior to the submittal of the bid.
- b. Bidder must be able to comply with the delivery schedule.
- c. Bidder must be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award.

6.2 Capital Region BOCES may make such investigations it deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the work. The bidder shall furnish to the BOCES, within five (5) days of a request, all such information and data for this purpose as may be requested. The BOCES reserves the right to reject any bid if the information submitted by, or investigation of, a bidder fails to satisfy the BOCES that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein. Conditional bids will not be accepted.

6.3 Bidder must include at least **three (3)** references identifying customers to whom the bidder has furnished and delivered Athletic Supplies.

**SECTION 7: EQUIVALENT GOODS**

7.1 Manufacturers’ brand names, if listed in specifications, are provided to indicate minimum requirements and bidding may be on brands specified, or equivalent. Specifications shall be furnished by bidder to support product equivalency. In the event of any claim by any unsuccessful bidder concerning or relating to the issue of “equal or better” or “or equal”,

the successful bidder agrees, that his own cost and expense, to defend such claim or claims and agrees to hold the BOCES free and harmless from any and all claims for loss or damage arising out of this transaction for any reasons.

## **SECTION 8: SPECIFICATION CLARIFICATION**

All questions about the meaning or intent of the specifications must be submitted to the designated person in writing.

8.2 Any interpretation, corrections and changes to this RFB and requirements or extensions to the submittal date will be made in writing by Addenda. Sole issuing authority of Addenda shall be vested in the Capital Region BOCES Purchasing Office, as entrusted by the Board. Addenda will be made available on the BidNet Direct Empire State Purchasing Group website for viewing by prospective bidders. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to check the New York's Empire State Purchasing Group website for all addenda. Bidders shall acknowledge the acceptance of all addenda in Exhibit A-7 of this document.

8.3 Any addenda so issued are to be considered a part of this RFB document. The BOCES will be bound only by responses given by formal written Addenda.

## **SECTION 9: DISQUALIFICATION OF BIDDER AND REJECTION OF BIDS**

9.1 Any one or more of the following, among others, may be considered sufficient for the disqualification of a bidder and the rejection of a bid:

- a. Evidence of collusion among bidders.
- b. Failure to satisfy the submittal requirements of the RFB.
- c. Lack of responsibility as shown by past work, reference, or other factors.
- d. Default or termination of other contracts or agreements.
- e. Illegible or vague bids.
- f. Other causes as deemed appropriate at the Board's sole and absolute discretion.

### **9.2 Late Bids**

All bids received after the time stated in the "Notice to Bidders", or the bid submission deadline as modified by formal addendum consistent with Section 8 of this Request for Bids, will not be considered and will be returned to the bidder. The bidder assumes the risk

of any delay in the mail or in the handling of the mail by employees of the BOCES. Whether sent by mail or by means of personal delivery, the bidder assumes responsibility for having his bid deposited on time at the place specified. The date/time stamp in the Purchasing Office shall be utilized in all cases to determine the official time of receipt.

### 9.3 Damaged/ Illegible Bids

The BOCES is not responsible for any bid or portion of a bid submittal that has been damaged or destroyed while in transit to the BOCES. Bidders should take the necessary precautions to ensure that their submittal is received intact. Illegible bid documents will be rejected.

### 9.4 Irregular Bids

Bids will be considered irregular and shall be subject to rejection for the following reasons:

- (a) If the bid is on a form other than that furnished by Capital Region BOCES, or, if the BOCES form is altered, or, if any part of the bidding documents is detached.
- (b) If there are unauthorized additions, conditional or alternate pay items, or irregularities of any kind which make the bid incomplete, indefinite, or otherwise ambiguous.

9.5 No oral, telephonic, electronic or faxed bids will be considered.

## **SECTION 10: MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS**

10.1 Bids cannot be altered or amended after submittal deadline. Any interlineation, alteration or erasure made before opening time must be initialed by the authorized signer of the bid, guaranteeing authenticity.

10.2 Bids may be modified or withdrawn at any time prior to the opening of bids by an appropriate document duly executed (in the manner that a bid must be executed) and delivered to the place where bids are to be submitted.

10.3 A bid may not be withdrawn or canceled by the bidder without justifiable cause following the date designated for the due date of bids, and bidder so agrees upon submittal of their bid.

10.4 If, prior to awarding of the bid or within three days after opening, whichever period is shorter, any bidder files a duly signed written notice with the BOCES and promptly thereafter demonstrates to the reasonable satisfaction of the BOCES that there was a material and substantial mistake in the preparation of its bid, that bidder may withdraw its bid in its entirety without penalty.

## **SECTION 11: BID FLASH DRIVE**

11.1 With this request for bids BOCES is providing the Vendor Bid Sheet/ Bid Proposal Form (Exhibit A-9) in Microsoft Excel format. With the bid submission, bidder shall provide the completed Vendor Bid Sheet/ Bid Proposal Form both in hard copy form and

electronically in Microsoft Excel format, on a USB flash drive. Bidder shall not change the electronic file format of the bid proposal form. Any change in the electronic format will prevent the flash drive from being read by BOCES' bid evaluation software and therefore may result in the rejection of the bid.

## **SECTION 12: SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS**

12.1 The bidder is required to submit Exhibits A, A-1 through A-9 plus any corresponding attachments in the sequence shown below. In order to aid the evaluation process, the bidder's submission should be in the following order and format:

1. Bid Acknowledgement Form
2. Non-Collusion Affidavit
3. Iran Divestment Act of 2012 Certification
4. Bidder's Statement on Sexual Harassment
5. Insurance Certification
6. References
7. Addenda Acknowledgement
8. Bidder's Form of Contract
9. Vendor Bid Sheet/ Bid Proposal Form
10. Flash Drive and Printed copy of completed Excel Bid Sheet, Catalogs/Descriptive literature/MSDS Sheets/Other Information (To be supplied by bidder, if applicable).

12.2 A Bidder's failure to provide all required documents with the bid submittal may result in rejection of the bid.

12.3 All information regarding brand, vendor catalog (stock #) and pricing, as well as substitute product information, must be included as per the bid sheet.

If substitute information is not provided, then it shall be assumed that the vendor is providing the product as per specifications in the same packaging requested and will be required to provide the requested item at the pricing offered upon delivery.

12.4 Signatures:

Bids must be signed in ink (preferably blue) by an authorized officer of the company. Facsimile, printed, or typewritten signatures are not acceptable.

## **SECTION 13: SUSPENSION OR DEBARMENT**

13.1 Vendors currently debarred from bidding on federal projects as identified in the federal System for Award Management (SAM) are ineligible for award under this Request for Bids. By submitting a bid for consideration, the Vendor is indicating to the BOCES that they have no active exclusions in SAM at the time of the bid submission.

## **SECTION 14: BID EVALUATION AND AWARD**

- 14.1 Bids shall remain valid until the award of a contract by the Board of Education, or until as otherwise rejected by Capital Region BOCES.
- 14.2 The final selection will be made based on the BOCES determination of the lowest responsible and responsive bidder(s), meeting the specifications and the requirements of this RFB.
- 14.3 The BOCES reserves the right to award this contract on a per-item or aggregate basis, whichever is most beneficial to the BOCES. Bidders need not submit bids for all items listed to be eligible for an award of this contract.
- 14.4 The BOCES reserves the right to purchase items pursuant to General Municipal Law 103 from New York State contracts, other government contracts, or New York State Preferred Sources within its discretion.

## **SECTION 15: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

- 15.1 The New York State Freedom of Information Law (FOIL), as set forth in Public Officers Law, Article 6, mandates public access to certain government records. Generally, bids submitted in response to this RFB may constitute government records subject to FOIL. Bids may contain, among other things, certain technical, financial, or other data and information that constitute trade secrets, if publicly disclosed, could cause substantial injury to the commercial enterprise's competitive position. To protect this information from disclosure under FOIL, bidders should specifically identify the pages of the bid that contain such information by properly marking the top of the applicable pages as "CONFIDENTIAL" and inserting the following statement in the front of its bid:

*The information or data on pages \_\_\_\_\_ of this bid, identified on the top thereof as "CONFIDENTIAL," contain financial, technical or other information which constitute trade secrets which, if publicly disclosed, would result in substantial injury to our competitive position. We request that BOCES use such information only for the evaluation of this bid, but we understand that the BOCES must comply with the provisions of the New York State Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) and that public disclosure of the information contained in this bid whether or not marked as "CONFIDENTIAL," and to make no claim for any damages as a result of any such disclosure by the BOCES pursuant to FOIL.*

- 15.2 In the event the BOCES receives a FOIL request for disclosure of information marked as "CONFIDENTIAL," the bidder shall be notified of the request and may expeditiously submit a detailed statement and explanation indicating the reasons the bidder has for believing that the information requested is exempt from disclosure under the law. This detailed statement and explanation shall be used by the BOCES in making its determination as to whether disclosure is required under the law.

## SECTION 16: INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

16.1 The successful bidder will be required to procure and maintain at its own expense, the following insurance coverage:

- (a) **Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance:** A policy or policies providing protection for Employees in the event of job-related injuries.
- (b) **Automobile Liability Insurance:** A policy or policies of insurance with the limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined for each accident because of bodily injury sickness or disease, sustained by any person, caused by accident, and arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of any automobile for damage because of injury to or destruction of property, including the loss of use thereof, caused by accident and arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of any owned, hired or leased automobile.
- (c) **Commercial General Liability Insurance:** A policy or policies providing commercial liability coverage including products/completed operations, and personal and advertising injury with limits of not less than:

Liability For:	Limits
Property Damage	\$1,000,000 each Occurrence / \$2,000,000 Aggregate
Bodily Injury	\$1,000,000 each Occurrence / \$2,000,000 Aggregate
Personal Injury	\$1,000,000 each Occurrence / \$2,000,000 Aggregate
Products/ Completed Operations	\$1,000,000 each Occurrence / \$2,000,000 Aggregate.

16.2 Capital Region BOCES shall be named as an additional insured on all liability policies.  
**RFB number must appear on insurance certificate.**

16.3 The policy shall not be changed or canceled until the expiration of thirty (30) days after written notice to the BOCES. It shall be automatically renewed upon expiration and continued in force unless BOCES is given at least thirty (30) days written notice to the contrary.

16.4 No work shall be commenced under the contract until the successful bidder has delivered to the BOCES Purchasing Agent, or her designee, proof of issuance of all policies of insurance required. If at any time, any of said policies should expire or become unsatisfactory to the BOCES, the successful bidder shall promptly obtain a new policy and submit proof of insurance of the same to the BOCES for approval. Upon failure of the successful bidder to furnish, deliver and maintain such insurance as above provided, the contract may, at the election of the BOCES, be forthwith declared suspended, discontinued or terminated. Failure of the successful bidder to procure and maintain any required insurance, shall not relieve the successful bidder from any liability under the contract, nor shall the insurance requirements be construed to conflict with the obligations of the successful bidder concerning indemnification.

## SECTION 17: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 17.1 Award Notification

The BOCES shall generate an award letter to the successful bidder. The successful bidder shall not sell, assign, transfer or convey this contract, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of the BOCES. Bidder shall not ship or deliver any item until receipt of a valid purchase order from the BOCES.

### 17.2 Contract/Agreement

The successful bidder's submittal, when accepted by the BOCES either by formal letter of acceptance or Purchase Order, shall legally constitute acceptance and therefore, be subject to all the terms and conditions of the bid documents. Any and all ambiguities in bid documents, bid awards, contracts or related documents, including tariffs, shall be construed in favor of BOCES.

### 17.3 Purchase Orders

Purchase orders to initiate delivery of goods awarded under this RFB will be issued directly by the BOCES, participating school district, or other bid participants as identified in this RFB. Invoices shall be issued by the successful bidder directly to the ordering entity.

### 17.4 Contract Administrator

The BOCES will designate a contract administrator with responsibility to ensure compliance with all the contractual term and conditions, including, but not limited to, the inspection and acceptance of the product(s) provided. The contract administrator will serve as liaison between the BOCES and the successful bidder.

### 17.5 Quantity Requirements

Quantity requirements, if provided in this RFB, are estimates only and are not to be construed as minimum or maximum purchase quantities. It is understood that the estimated quantities of products may be increased, decreased or omitted, without in any way invalidating bid prices. BOCES reserves the right to place orders on an as needed basis throughout the bid term, at the awarded bid prices. There are to be no minimum order quantities or dollar amounts required by the bidder. Bids stipulating minimum quantity or dollar value orders will not be considered.

### 17.6 Delivery Terms and Conditions

- a. Unless otherwise specified herein, all deliveries shall be made within ***14 calendar days*** of vendor's receipt of Purchase Order.
- b. The Purchase Order shall designate the place of delivery. There will be scheduled hours and a specific location for product(s) deliveries which do not conflict with the BOCES peak traffic times. Delivery hours are between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. except on holidays. Deliveries may not cause interference with BOCES operations.

- c. All bid prices shall include freight and shall be quoted F.O.B. Destination, inside delivery. No additional charges such as fuel surcharges and hazardous material charges will be paid. Title and risk of loss shall not pass to the BOCES or participant districts, if applicable, until the BOCES or district actually receives and takes possession of the goods at the place of delivery.
- d. Prior to payment, items furnished, or work performed will be inspected by the Purchasing Agent or her designee to determine their conformity to specification. No payment will be made for items not meeting specification.
- e. Bidder shall be required to deliver the product(s) to the designated location within the time indicated in the bid document. The BOCES and participant districts, if applicable, retain the right to purchase elsewhere and charge back to the bidder any increase if the bidder does not deliver within the time period indicated in this RFB.
- f. Deliveries shall be accompanied by an itemized delivery receipt or bill of lading listing the items and quantities being delivered.
- g. Goods will be packaged, unless otherwise specifically designated in the specifications, in accordance with good commercial practices. Orders must be individually boxed by each purchase order issued within each shipping container and marked with the proper P.O number accordingly. Each shipping container shall be clearly and permanently packed and marked on the exterior as follows:
  - i. Name and address of successful bidder.
  - ii. Name and address of receiving department and/or delivery location, teacher's name and the BOCES/district purchase order number(s). Packing slips or other suitable shipping documents shall accompany each shipment and shall show the information stated in (a); (b); and descriptive information as to the items delivered and/or services performed including container number, total number of the containers (i.e., box 1 of 4 boxes); the number of the container bearing the packing slip, quantity, etc. The successful bidder shall bear cost of packaging unless otherwise provided. Goods shall be suitably packed to secure lowest transportation costs and to conform to requirements of common carriers and any applicable specifications. BOCES count or weight shall be final and conclusive in shipments not accompanied by packing lists. The successful bidder shall handle all claims with carriers and in case of damaged goods, shall ship replacement goods immediately upon notification by the BOCES of damage.
- h. Goods delivered must fully comply with all provisions of the contract as to time of delivery, quality and the like. Goods supplied under this contract shall be subject to BOCES approval. If goods delivered do not fully conform and delivery time has expired, this shall constitute a breach and successful bidder shall not have the right to substitute

conforming goods. Where the time for performance has not yet expired, the successful bidder may reasonably notify the BOCES of successful bidder's intention to cure; may pick up defective goods; and may then deliver conforming goods within the contract time but not afterward unless extension was granted as previously provided. If defective goods are not picked up within five (5) workdays after notification, the defective goods will become a donation to the BOCES for disposition.

- i. Bidder shall file with the carrier all claims for breakage, imperfections, and other losses, which will be deducted from invoices. The BOCES shall not be responsible, however, when practicable will note for the benefit of the successful bidder when packages are not received in acceptable condition.
- j. The BOCES shall not accept any delivery on Saturdays, Sundays, or legal holidays. Special accommodations may be made on deliveries required for daily consumption in the event of an emergency.
- k. All delivery, freight charges, fuel surcharges and hazardous material surcharges (FOB BOCES designated location) shall be included in the bid prices. No additional charges will be paid.
- l. The cost of any applicable state or federal tariffs must be included in the bid pricing as submitted.

#### 17.7 Payments

- a. The BOCES will make payment only after receipt and acceptance by the BOCES of the product(s) ordered.
- b. Vendor invoices shall show the purchase order number and shall be mailed to the Divisions as indicated on the Purchase Order.
- c. Payment terms extended to the BOCES and districts shall be no less than 30 days from date of invoice.
- d. The vendor's invoice shall state any prompt payment discounts available.
- e. The BOCES shall not pay any additional freight, minimum order charges, fuel or other surcharge or delivery charges.
- f. Payments of any claim shall not preclude BOCES from making claim for adjustment of any item found not to have been in accordance with specifications. Payments shall be made by BOCES with all rights reserved.
- g. Payments for the used portion of an inferior delivery will be made by the BOCES on an adjusted price basis.

h. The BOCES is exempt (tax-exempt #14-6009582) from federal, state, and municipal sales/excise taxes. Other bid participants, if applicable, are also tax exempt and tax exempt documentation will be furnished after award upon bidder's request. Therefore, bid prices shall not include any such taxes.

i. BOCES and bid participants will furnish all required contact information for delivery, contract administration and accounts payable as required by the bidder. Neither BOCES nor bid participants will complete vendor credit applications or sign to vendor credit terms and conditions or provide personal guarantee of payment.

## **SECTION 18: CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

18.1 No public official from the State of New York, County of Albany, Schoharie, Schenectady or Saratoga or any local governmental unit located within the above counties shall have interest in the Agreement.

## **SECTION 19: VENUE**

19.1 This RFB will be governed and construed according to the laws of the State of New York. By submission of a bid all bidders agree that the Supreme Court, State of New York, County of Albany, the United States District Court, Northern District of New York shall be the venue for any actions brought under this RFB.

## **SECTION 20: ADVERTISING**

20.1 The successful bidder shall not advertise or publish, without the BOCES prior written approval, the fact that the BOCES has entered into a contract, except to the extent necessary to comply with proper requests for information from an authorized representative of the federal, state, or local government.

## **SECTION 21: INTERFERENCE**

21.1 There shall be no interference with BOCES operations in the performance or delivery of the product(s) ordered.

## **SECTION 22: TERMINATION RIGHTS BY THE BOCES**

22.1 The BOCES reserves the right to terminate the contract immediately in the event the successful bidder fails to meet delivery or completion schedules, or otherwise perform in accordance with these specifications. Breach of contract or default authorizes the BOCES to award to the next lowest bidder or purchase elsewhere and charge the full increase in cost and handling to the defaulting successful bidder.

22.2 BOCES may terminate the contract without cause upon thirty (30) day's written notice.

## **SECTION 23: REPRESENTATIONS**

23.1 No information derived from inspection of BOCES records or reports of investigation concerning the agreement will in any way relieve the successful bidder of its responsibility or from properly fulfilling its obligations under the contract. The BOCES may have provided information as a convenience to the bidder and did so without any warranty whatsoever by BOCES. The successful bidder is responsible for making its own conclusions and interpretations from the data supplied by BOCES and from information available from other sources.

## **SECTION 24: CUMULATIVE RIGHTS**

24.1 The rights and remedies provided by this agreement are cumulative and the use of one right or remedy by a party shall not preclude or waive the right to use any or all of the remedies.

## **SECTION 25: INDEMNIFICATION**

25.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Contractor agrees to hold harmless, indemnify and defend the Albany-Schoharie-Schenectady-Saratoga Board of Cooperative Educational Services, all its employees/representatives, and all participating school districts, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including, without limitations, legal expenses on a solicitor and client basis) arising out of, or in consequence of, any and all acts, omissions, or negligence of the Contractor. Further, the Contractor agrees to hold harmless, indemnify and defend the BOCES, all its employees/representatives, and all participating school districts from and against all suits, actions and proceedings by whomsoever made, brought, or prosecuted, and in any manner based upon, arising out of, related to, occasioned by, or attributable to the infringement or contribution to the infringement of any intellectual or industrial property right, by the articles, methods, processes, or act employed by, or plans, drawings, specifications or other written data provided by the Contractor or its employees in concert with providing services.

## **SECTION 26: DEFAULT**

26.1 If the successful bidder is in default, the BOCES may, in its discretion, do all things necessary to affect compliance with the laws, regulation, by-laws, directives, rules and conventions referred to herein, and the successful bidder shall, on demand by the BOCES, reimburse the BOCES for all costs incurred by the BOCES for that purpose.

## **SECTION 27: PATENTS/ COPYRIGHTS**

27.1 The successful bidder agrees to protect the BOCES from claims involving infringements of patents and/or copyrights. By submission of this bid and as part of the awarded contract for sale, the bidder agrees to ascertain whether goods manufactured according to the specifications will cause the rightful claim of any third person by way of infringement or

the like. The BOCES makes no warranty that the production of goods meeting the specification will not cause such a claim, and in no event shall the BOCES be liable to the bidder for indemnification should the bidder be sued on the grounds of infringement or the like. If the bidder is of the opinion that an infringement or the like will result, the bidder will notify the BOCES to this effect in writing within two (2) weeks after the award of the contract. If the BOCES does not receive notice and is subsequently held liable for the infringement or the like, bidder will save the BOCES harmless. If the bidder in good faith ascertains that production of the goods according to the specifications will result in infringement or the like, the awarded contract shall be null and void.

## **SECTION 28: REMEDIES**

## **SECTION 38: SAVINGS/ FORCE MAJEURE**

38.1 The awarded bidder shall not be responsible for its delay or failure to perform if neither the fault nor negligence of the bidder, its officers, employees, or agents contributed to such delay or failure to perform, and bidder's delay or failure to perform is due directly to acts of God, wars, acts of public enemies, strikes, fires, floods, or other similar cause beyond the control of the bidder, or for any of the foregoing which affect subcontractors or suppliers and no alternate source of supply is available to the bidder. Within five business days of becoming aware of such cause, bidder shall notify the BOCES Purchasing Agent of the delay or potential delay and the cause(s) thereof.
